DIY STAR HEX NUT ORNAMENT



INSTRUCTIONS



Step 3: Assembly and Gluing

- 1. Lay out complete star pattern before gluing
- 2. Begin gluing from the top, working your way down
- 3. Leave the center of the star open

Step 1: Create Star Points

- 1. Create six triangles for each star point
- 2. For each triangle:
 - Place one hex nut at the top
- Position two nuts below it on the flats
 - Add three nuts at the bottom

Step 2: Connect the Points

- 1. Add one nut on the bottom right and left sides
- 2. Connect triangles to form top and bottom of the star

Step 4: Finishing

- 1. Allow glue to dry completely (1-24 hours)
- 2. Weave twine or ribbon through top nut
- 3. Tie a secure knot for hanging

Optional Step 5: Personal Photo Frame

- 1. Measure the open center of your star
- 2. Cut photo to fit the opening
- 3. Carefully glue photo to the back of the star frame
- 4. Optional: Add clear plastic cover for protection

MATERIALS LIST

- 42 Hex Finish Nuts (1/4-20): Metal Options:
 - * Aluminum (Recommended)
 - * Zinc
 - * Stainless Steel
 - * Brass
 - * Silicon Bronze
- E6000 glue
- 6" piece of Ribbon or twine
- Optional Photo Frame Materials:
- * Personal photo
- * Scissors or circular craft punch
- * Clear plastic sheet (optional for photo protection)

TIPS AND TRICKS

- Always do a complete dry layout before gluing
- Protect work surface with newspaper
- Experiment with different nut sizes
- Black and white photos create a classic look
- We recommend laying down newspaper or some other material to protect the surface you are working on
